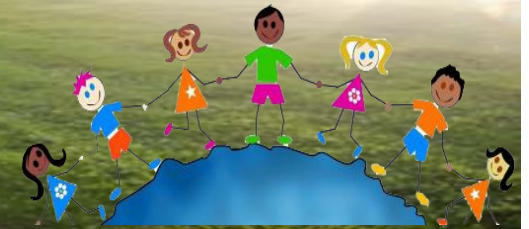




DOES YOUR PATH

**This world is full of interesting  
people...**

- Some simply say that there is no God.
- Others say, "I just don't know!"
- Some hold religious beliefs that seem right to them or their families.
- And others find peace and life through the God of the Bible.

Those who believe in the God of the Bible call themselves Christians. They understand that they are sinners, and that a holy and perfect God must judge sin.

Christians also rejoice in the fact that they have been forgiven. They no longer fear death because, after leaving this world, they will spend eternity in the presence of an almighty God who is love. They have asked this God to forgive them, and He has answered their prayer.

This forgiveness is available to every person who is alive today because God sent his Son Jesus to suffer the penalty that is duly theirs. All of us have sinned and are guilty before a holy God.

The Bible says it this way:

**“There is no one righteous, not even one... there is no fear of God before their eyes.” (Romans 3:10, 18)**

But God has a solution for the problem of sin:

**“For God so loved the world that he gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life.” (John 3:16)**

**“Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God’s wrath remains on him.” (John 3:36)**

And so it is that all who turn to God’s Son, Jesus Christ the Savior, and ask him to forgive their sins, will be saved from eternal damnation (the place called hell) and spend eternity with God in heaven. Jesus said:

**“I am the way, the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.” (John 14:6)**



This is a very powerful and absolutely non-negotiable truth. It is exclusive – there is no other way. But it is also all-inclusive because God desires that all should come to know the way of salvation and become His children through trusting Jesus Christ for their salvation.

People who deny that there is a God, or just don’t now, or cling to a false hope by following gods or religions that cannot deliver what they promise, have absolutely no hope. Sadly, they will face an eternity apart from the one true God in a place called hell.

But there is always hope that some will come to God the Father through His Son Jesus, the Savior.

It is for this reason – **out of love for the lost** – that Christians tell others about God’s provision for them. **The good news is that you can be saved from an eternity of doom!** God wants you to know that His Son died for you to pay the penalty for your sins. He also wants you to know that Jesus rose again from the dead to live forever, sitting at the Father’s right hand. He is ready and able to save you if you turn to Him for forgiveness, believing that He paid the penalty that was due to you (the wages of sin is death).

Sadly, some people try to gain God’s acceptance by doing good works. They follow a moral code, give money and do good deeds. They may even trust in a religious system that promises to fulfill their hopes. But God cannot be bribed with anything we may or may not do. And while the path of doing good and being a nice person seems acceptable in our own eyes, from God’s point of view it’s like trying to enter heaven by the back door. He has determined that there is only ONE way, and only ONE door. That is why Jesus could say that HE is the only way and the only gate:

**“I am the gate; whoever enters through me will be saved.” (John 10:9)**

**THE CHOICE IS YOURS—CHOOSE WISELY!**

The wrong choice will result in a terrible outcome—**your eternal life is at stake!**



The right decision, on the other hand, will result in peace with God and eternal security. I hope you will make the right choice. I have made mine, and I thank God for my salvation.
